



## Evergreen Azalea List

---

- Blue Danube** Purple with red blotch. Blooms May. 18-24" tall, spreading
- Everest** White with light green blotch. Blooms May. 36-48" tall, rounded. Likes partial shade
- Gaiety** Rose pink with dark blotch. Blooms late April. 36-48" tall, rounded. Likes sun
- Girard's Fuchsia** Deep fuchsia, 3" large. Blooms mid April. 36-48" tall, rounded
- Girard's Jeremiah** Deep pink; double. Blooms late April. 24-36" tall, spreading. Likes sun
- Girard's Scarlet** Large, scarlet red. Blooms early May. 24-48" tall, rounded
- Gumpo White** White, 3" large, very profuse. Blooms May. 10-12" tall, mounding
- Helen Close** White, 4" large. Blooms May. 12-15" tall; low, compact
- Hino Crimson** Crimson, profuse. Blooms late March. 24-36" tall, rounded. Likes sun
- Mother's Day** Large, red; semi-double. Blooms May. 24-36" tall, rounded
- Purple Splendor** Light purple double. Blooms April. 24-48" tall, rounded. Likes partial shade
- Rosebud** Light pink, very double. Blooms May. 24-36" tall, rounded
- Silver Sword** Vivid red, 2" large. Blooms April. 24-48" tall. Unusual cream-edged foliage
- Stewartsonian** Bright red. Blooms late March. 24-48" tall, rounded. Likes partial shade

### REBLOOMING AZALEAS

These varieties bloom heavily in the spring, with a lighter second bloom in late summer to fall. For best bloom in the Pacific Northwest, plant in full sun.

### AUTUMN ENCORE SERIES

- Autumn Amethyst** Fuchsia purple, single. 4' tall. Foliage turns purple in cold
- Autumn Bonfire** Glowing red, semi-double. 36" tall, spreading
- Autumn Jewel** Magenta pink, single. 4' tall, rounded. Foliage turns purple in cold. Cold hardy
- Autumn Lily** Pure white, single, sometimes has dashes of purple. 4-5' tall. Cold hardy
