

Hostas, occasionally called "plantain lilies" or "funkia", are among the best-loved shade plants. Hostas are grown primarily for their striking heart-shaped foliage in shades of blue, green, chartreuse, or variegated with cream and white. Spikes of flowers, usually lavender but sometimes white or light blue, add a vertical accent in mid to late summer. Hummingbirds and bees are attracted to the flowers. Some varieties have fragrant flowers; these are noted in our list below.

Hostas like a soil rich in organic matter and plenty of summer water; they appreciate a dose of slow-release flower food (such as Dr. Earth or E.B. Stone Rose and Flower Food) once a year in spring when you see the new growth. Slugs like hostas; bait regularly to prevent damage. Hostas with heavy, corrugated foliage are less attractive to slugs; these ones are listed as slug resistant.

All hostas like partial to full shade; a few will take more sun (generally up to ¾ sun—not hot afternoon sun). The more sun-tolerant ones are noted as well.

Please note that hosts can take several years for foliage to attain adult characteristics (color, variegation, texture). The immature hosts in a pot may look different from the variety description.

Hosta of the Year Winners are indicated by HY in parentheses after the name. These are hostas that are striking and that perform well across the country. Great Plant Picks are particularly fine performers in the Puget Sound region; they are indicated by GPP after the name.
