



DECIDUOUS MAGNOLIAS (*Magnolia X soulangeana* and hybrids)

Ann Height 15-20 feet, width 10-15 feet. Rounded multi-trunk form. Purple to pink flowers in mid spring. Protect from harsh winter winds.

Ballerina (M. x loebneri) Height 10-12 feet. Fragrant starry flowers are white blushed pink

Black Tulip Height 15-20 feet, width 6-10 feet. Rounded tulip-shaped flowers; deep wine red.

Butterflies Height 20-25 feet, width 15-20 feet. 3-4" flowers in April—soft yellow and fragrant

Cameo Height 12-15 feet, width 6-8 feet. Prolific magenta tulip-shaped flowers

Cleopatra Height 20 feet, width 8 feet. Deep pink, fragrant, saucer flowers. Reblooms in late summer

Elizabeth Height 18-20 feet—width 12-15 feet. Upright pyramidal shape. Sun or part shade. Elegant buds open to large, fragrant, primrose-yellow blooms with red stamens in spring.

Felix Jury Height 20-40 feet, width 10-15 feet. Very large fragrant hot pink flowers

Galaxy Height 12-20 feet, width 6-8 feet. Pyramidal shape. Likes full sun. Slightly fragrant "saucer" flowers; buds are dark red-purple, opening to rose-purple inside, lighter outside.

Genie Height 10-15 feet, width 6-8 feet. Fragrant tulip-shaped flower is deep wine red

Leonard Messel (M. x loebneri) Height 15-25 feet, width 6-10 feet. Rounded multi-trunk tree. Deep pink buds open to star-shaped lilac pink flowers. Protect from wind.

Merrill Height 20-25 feet, width 20-25 feet. Rounded multi-trunk tree. Fragrant white flowers. Protect from harsh winds.

Rustica Rubra Height 15-20 feet, width 12-15 feet. Broad shrub like form. Rounded, deep rosy-pink and white "saucer" flowers. Will sometimes rebloom in fall.

Sunsation Height 15-20 feet, width 8-10 feet. Large flowers are glowing golden with purple at base. Late bloomer (late April), very cold hardy—excellent for areas with late frost.

Susan Height 6-8', width 4-7 feet; compact bushy form. Prolific magenta lily-shaped flowers

Vulcan Height 20-25 feet, width 20-25 feet. Upright in youth, matures to broadly rounded and open form. 10-12" saucer-shaped flowers are magenta to ruby

STAR MAGNOLIAS (*Magnolia stellata*)

Royal Star Height 10-20 feet, width 6-8 feet. Abundant large, fragrant, double white flowers

EVERGREEN MAGNOLIAS (*Magnolia grandiflora*) Fragrant, large white flowers in early summer, followed by showy seed pods. Evergreen foliage is shiny deep green on top, velvety brown underneath.

Baby Grand Dwarf with compact narrow form. Height 8-10 feet, width 6-8' feet. Good glossy foliage, rusty brown underneath. Extremely fragrant.

D. D. Blanchard Height 40-50 feet, width 25-35 feet. Pyramidal shape. Lustrous dark leaves with rusty undersides. Fragrant, large, cup-shaped white flowers in summer.

Kay Parris Height 15-20 feet, width 8-10 feet. Long blooming variety. Dense compact habit. Shiny foliage; orange-brown underneath.

Little Gem Dwarf with compact narrow form. Height 10-15 feet, width 6-8 feet. Dark green foliage; chocolate on underside. Often re-blooms in late summer.

Teddy Bear Height 10-15 feet; spread 6-10 feet. Smaller foliage and flowers than most evergreen magnolias.

EVERGREEN MICHELIAS (*Michelia doltsopa* AKA *Magnolia doltsopa*) Evergreen Michelias are sometimes botanically classed as magnolias. They grow as upright, dense shrubs or can be pruned as small trees. The large, fragrant white flowers look like grandiflora flowers, except they are produced all up and down the branches, not just at the tips like other magnolias. Michelias are therefore literally covered in bloom in early summer.
